MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 28th JUNE 2022 at 7.30pm

1277 Minutes of the previous meeting : Held Tues 12th April 2022 agreed as a true record

1278 Matters arising :

- **Church gate :** TS had contacted re snagging to finish – will contact again to arrange to meet with Cllr Mitchell. Noted lighting remained outstanding and Cllr Loxley confirmed the Church had agreed re payment for lighting
- **Website :** Cllr Mitchell shared proposed photos of / heading for website – all reviewed and agreed the one with the photo
- **Bromley Trough :** The pipe replacement next week by Cllrs Mitchell and Loxley – we thanked Cllr Mitchell for sourcing the pipe and working to replace it.
- **Lamppost hanging baskets at Howbrook:** Noted we had only got 4 so not even existing number Cllr Wing to send google map photo with the new ones requested to Kathryn for onward to the council and noting we were short on the originals anyway.
- **The Avenue and tarmacng :** This remains outstanding and in debate with the Estate and builders.
- **Bus stops re staining:** Cllr Wing gave feedback re the email trails she had received from SYPTE when checking we could undertake this via a decorator whom had looked at the 3 bus stops. We noted it was a shame given they had been re-roofed to let them go to decay. She had received strict instructions to carry out risk assessments and moving of a temporary bus stop etc. Cllr Wing to contact Richard Holden at the council regarding this to check if they can do them before we proceed further.
